Collegiate Chapter Dues, Fees and Housing Costs

Each chapter establishes its own costs for housing and meals, dues and other fees. Chapter costs are determined by chapter members.

National Dues and Fees

Our members pay national dues and fees each semester to support the activities and operations of our organization.

One-time New Member Dues & Fees† \$295*

National new member fee	\$100
New member initiation fee	\$100
Badge fee†	\$95

†Minimum fee. Actual cost depends on the type of badge selected.

*One-time fees are due the semester the new member joins the sorority.

Semesterly National Dues \$92.50
